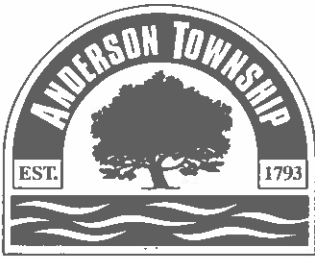

1. Welcome / Call to Order

Mr. Edgerton, President, called the meeting to order at 3:02 p.m. and welcomed everyone to the meeting.

2. Roll Call / Announcements

Members Ronald Edgerton, Katie Buchman, Christy Cauley, and Dee Stone, were present, as was Steve Sievers, Executive Director.

3. Introductions / Contact Information Updates

As the membership remained the same from 2024, introductions were not necessary. A roster was distributed in the meeting packet to GATBC members so that they could make updates to their contact information. There were no changes.

4. Approval of Meeting Minutes

Mr. Edgerton stated that the March 2024 meeting minutes were distributed for review following last year's meeting. Ms. Stone moved to accept the March 11, 2024, minutes, Ms. Buchmann seconded. A vote was taken, and the minutes were accepted and filed.

5. Annual Report / GATBC Overview / Role With Current Projects

Mr. Sievers provided an overview of the GATBC's efforts in the last year. The report also offered somewhat of a historical reflection for those who are interested. The size of this summary was trimmed from the past and probably can be further reduced moving forward.

Mr. Sievers stated he continues to try to focus the narrative on activity on more recent GATBC activity, which has been centered upon continued support for the Senior Center and parade. He remarked that he continues to think about ways the GATBC may connect with community efforts and asked members to do the same. This entailed also trying to get a sense of what other 501-c-3 organizations served the Anderson Area, and whether there may be partnership opportunities. This was studied following last March's meeting.

The report was accepted and filed.

6. Report on the Treasury and Account Activity Summary

Mr. Sievers provided an oral and written overview (which is attached) of the Treasury and GATBC Account Summary. He also noted that the Anderson Township Senior Center continues to be the primary activity area for the GATBC, with regard to funds expended and collected.

In summary, 2024 was a relatively quiet year. At the current time, staff is working with Flynn & Associates to prepare the 2024 tax filing, and to stay on top of finances and investments in an effort to continue to grow the non-earmarked funds. This includes monitoring the interest rates in the Township's Capital One 360 and 5th/3rd Money Market accounts.

Mr. Sievers noted the Township also supports the Senior Center, both with operating funds and also capital improvements, and there is more than \$130,000 in their GATBC account. Thus, while additional donations are certainly welcome, the financial picture is strong and perhaps moving forward, those funds, many of which were from the Ayer Trust, might also be used to not only benefit the Senior Center, but seniors in general in the community through the Center's efforts. The Senior Center staff has also noted how these funds allow them to offer a wide array of high-quality offerings (entertainment, lectures, classes, etc.) for members.

The group discussed banking and interest rates at length, focusing on whether the GATBC could avoid a minimum balance, such as the \$50,000 that is required by 5th/3rd Bank. Mr. Sievers agreed and said he'd be happy to talk with the Bank, and perhaps other financial institutions, to see what options exist. It was also noted that 2024 was a very difficult year with the 5th/3rd fraud related issues and change in the checking practices.

Ms. Stone noted that with the Forest Hills Foundation, they found greater support with local banks who were involved in the Anderson community. Mr. Sievers stated that some of these may be options, and a few have been involved with GATBC activities, such as the parade.

Mr. Sievers stated that he would:

- Talk with 5th/3rd on various options to increase the interest rate and in doing so, ensure that they have the mailing address correct (listed at Anderson Center) for all three accounts
- Possibly reach out to other banks for comparisons of benefits/costs with 5th/3rd
- Review and report back to the GATBC on the interest rates for all accounts, including the Capital One 360 funds

The report was accepted and filed.

7. Other Business / Next Items

Mr. Edgerton asked if there was any other business or new items. Mr. Sievers noted again that an effort was made in early 2024 to see whether there may be a way for the GATBC to not only support new events or projects that benefit the community, but also 501-c-3 organizations that are based or have a strong presence in Anderson Township. Ms. Cauley provided information that was very helpful for the group to assess what organizations existed in the Anderson Area.

While the GATBC could help to promote or raise exposure of these opportunities, there are many great causes out there. Further, the better opportunity, historically, was for the GATBC to fill in for groups, events, etc. that align with our mission, but for which there is not yet a formal structure. Thus, perhaps the group could bridge the gap for these start-ups. The downside is it's hard to identify or reach out to such organizations. Instead, the GATBC continues to promote ourselves as a resource and hope that we can match up with such a cause.

There was conversation among the group that focused, in part, on continuing to grow and support the Senior Center and elderly population in general in our area. The Center's membership was at an all-time high but there was still capacity for it to serve both its regular members and community at large. This may include daytime events and offerings that can't fit at the Senior Center, which could occur at Anderson Center.

Mr. Sievers also remarked that staff will continue to think about ways to promote GATBC's role with possible projects and bring activities to the groups for consideration and asked that members do the same. He will also be in touch with draft tax documents for the GATBC's review.

8. Election of Officers

Mr. Edgerton stated that he felt the group was working well together if it was acceptable to everyone, he was happy to continue to serve in the same role and perhaps others may too. Members discussed this and Ms. Stone moved to appoint Ron Edgerton as President, Christy Cauley as Vice President, and Katie Buchmann at Secretary/Treasurer for 2025. There was no further discussion, and the motion was approved.

9. Adjournment

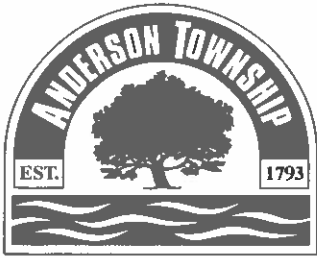
Ms. Buchmann moved, Ms. Stone seconded, to adjourn the meeting at 4:02 p.m.

March 2026 Report

In 2026, the GATBC continues to provide administrative and financial support for a number of groups or events. These include the very popular Anderson Township Independence Day Parade. Historically, sponsors donate funds that are received by the Commission, and in turn, many of the expenses associated with the Parade were then paid by the Commission. Sponsorship outreach paused in 2020 and 2021 but resumed in 2022.

A second, also very popular, event was the Anderson Farmers' Market. In 2022, all remaining GATBC funds were transferred to the Market, which is now an independent stand-alone legal organization.

The GATBC's role expanded into a third area in early 2009, with a request from the Anderson Township Veterans' Memorial for the Commission to help in an oversight function for their fundraising efforts, and the Memorial was dedicated in 2017. There remain some funds in the GATBC account for ongoing maintenance, repairs or modifications to the Memorial area, though activity has been very light in recent years.

In 2015, the GATBC was approached by the Anderson Township Fire & Rescue Department, who was seeking an entity to manage donations that are made to their department, and a decision was made in March 2015 to assist in this manner. In recent years, the GATBC was utilized for the Ayer Trust donation in 2018, with a large expenditure in 2020 for AED devices. The ATFD used these funds in recent years to purchase paint and supplies for fire hydrants in response to a surge in volunteer interest to assist with painting, and for replacement AED batteries.

Also, in 2015, members agreed to assist where needed with the Anderson Township Food Truck Rally and the Passport to Anderson program. The GATBC assisted with managing donations and expenses for both events, and remaining funds were shifted to the "non-earmarked" area

In 2017, the GATBC was asked to provide assistance for a number of causes. One of which has become the largest focus of the GATBC's current work (at least the Executive Director's time). This entails support for the Anderson Township Senior Center. The GATBC manages donations, and related expenses, to help finance equipment, programs, etc.

Also, in 2017, members of the community expressed interest in helping to secure donations to advance the Ohio River Trail effort, within the City of Cincinnati. The GATBC agreed to serve as such a conduit for contributions, with staff's assistance. The revenue from this outreach was expended in 2022 as the project was completed, and a management structure is in place for other Anderson Trails projects, which may seek to tap into community financial support.

In 2017, staff suggested that some unencumbered funds be allocated for the Township's 225th Anniversary in 2018, and members agreed to allocate \$2,500 for this purpose. The funds were utilized by providing assistance for a fall event celebration, and towards a "legacy project that entailed the installation of three 225th interpretive markers that display and discuss the history of three areas of the Township. Members felt this was relevant use of GATBC monies, as the organization was founded in the early 1990s to assist at that time with the 200th Anniversary.

In early 2018, the GATBC assumed a role with the Eileen Ayer Trust. Ms. Ayer named the Anderson Township Fireman's Association (which is no longer in existence) and the Anderson Senior Center, as beneficiaries of her estate. Due to the GATBC's role with these groups, staff worked with the Executor for the Trust, to manage these funds.

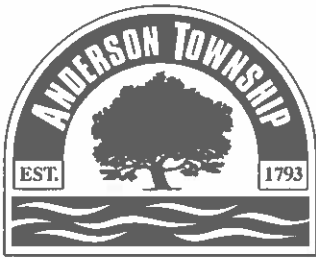
In 2018, \$100,000 was provided to the GATBC, which was used by the Fire & Rescue Department, for community-wide safety efforts. This included the 2020 purchase of automatic external defibrillators (AEDs), that were placed in all 22 Anderson Township owned Sheriff cruisers. Additionally, \$186,000 was provided to the GATBC in 2019-2020 for the Anderson Township Senior Center. Staff continues to work with the Anderson Township Senior Center and Anderson Township Senior Center Advisory Committee on projects using those funds.

The Commission has and continues to accept and manages donations and activities that closely align with its missions. There are no other current activities beyond those mentioned above, in conjunction. Finally, staff will be filing its annual report with the state and with the assistance of UHY, an accounting firm, to again prepare the tax filing for 2025 that was recently filed.

Greater Anderson Township Betterment Commission (GATBC)

March 2026 Report on the Treasury

The balance of the Commission, as of February 28, 2026, is \$211,447.47 (based on 5th/3rd Accounts and Capital One 360 Statement). Note, there are 3 checks, totaling \$1,950, which were issued prior to February 28, 2026, and were not cashed by that date. Thus, the actual balance is \$209,497.47. For comparison and tracking, the balance at the end of the past several calendar years is as follows:

In 2025, \$14,020.24 was collected and \$36,365.11 expended by the Commission. Revenues were the result of a number of areas, most notably donations to the Senior Center and Fire & Rescue mission. Other revenues are derived from interest on the Capital One 360 and 5th/3rd accounts. Expenses during 2025 were centered on Senior Center programming, the parade, and administrative items/fees including State and Federal filings.

So far in 2026, the financial changes in the GATBC account are due to expenses or donations for the Senior Center or interest. A request for parade donations, and related reservations/advanced payment for the projected costs for this year's event, have not yet occurred.

Again, funds from the Ayer Trust were shifted to the interest-bearing Capital One 360 or 5th/3rd savings or money market accounts beginning in 2018 and 2023, respectively, these are shifted to the 5/3rd checking account when needed for expenses by the Fire & Rescue Department or Senior Center as a minimum \$50,000 balance in our checking account is required.

It is the intent that each of the GATBC's programs or activities is self-supporting. Thus, the funds collected and expended for these items is earmarked so that revenues collected by each support future year's events, rather than being credited as "non-earmarked" funds. The interest, however, is currently being used for non-earmarked purposes, including planned administrative costs relating to the amount of the GATBC treasury (accounting services, etc.). The attached table depicts the net change in each activity over the past several years, and other information outlines GATBC expenditures by project area for 2025 and 2026 (though February 28th).

The current non-earmarked portion of the February 28, 2026, actual balance, which is \$209,497.47, is \$11,555.20.
