Call to Participants:

Anderson Township presents the inaugural Nights of Township Lights, an interactive sculptural display to be showcased at the Anderson Center. The Township invites groups, individuals or businesses to join in on a new Holiday Celebration! Show off your creativity with a temporary art installation with a focus on lighting and interaction, highlighting the overall theme of a holiday season, whether its food, family or how you celebrate. These display/sculptures must be able to withstand inclement weather for up to two weeks. While creativity is encouraged, we will also accept proposals that include purchased displays. If your organization wishes to participate monetarily rather than by creating a display, please let us know, as this is also an option.

Proposals must include a brief narrative of ideas and some sort of visual that illustrates what you are proposing, the potential power needs of the proposal, approximate height, width and length, if the proposal must be on level ground or can be located in the grass, and any other potential needs of the proposal. Please include 1st, 2nd and 3rd location choices based on the attached diagram of the Anderson Center.

This is a great chance to showcase your organization, business or self and participate with other Township community members, especially during our kick off event set to take place on Saturday, December 5, 2026 from 4pm to 6pm on the Lower Level Plaza at the Anderson Center. There will be a number of activities of families, from crafts to hot chocolate, as well as performances from local organizations.

Proposals must be submitted by September 1, 2026. Notices of acceptance into the Nights of Township Lights will be issued by September 17, 2026. Displays need to be installed by 5pm on December 4, 2026. Displays will need to be removed by Monday, January 4, 2027 at 5pm.
