

#### How did we start?

- 1941:One career firefighter and several volunteers
- One station
- Dedicated people made and still make a difference



#### How do we provide services today?

69 career firefighter personnel, of which 60 are paramedics

Minimum of 17 personnel on duty everyday across the four stations

7 Medic Units (min. 4 staffed)

6 Engines (min 3 staffed)

1 Quint (staffed every day)

6 Boats


Total runs for 2022





EMS varies from 72% to 77% - typical is 73% recently


#### When do we respond?

# A serious EMS call receives 3-4 paramedic/firefighters and possibly 1 additional EMT -

- 2 on an engine/quint
- 2 on the medic unit

#### Why?

- Better patient care
  - Each medic/EMT has designated function on the team
  - Increases overall efficiency
- Reduces personnel injuries (carrying equipment, lifting patients etc.)
