## **Process Background**

- □ As a participant in the Hamilton County Community Development Program beginning March 1, 2021, Anderson Township is eligible to submit projects for grant consideration for FY 2021 FY 2023
- □ Projects must meet the requirements set forth in 24 CFR Part 580.201, Eligible Activities
- Communities seeking funds must hold a public hearing and submit potential project(s) by November 23, 2020
- □ A minimum five-day public comment period must occur prior to December 4, 2020 this presentation is targeted towards that comment period and was posted at <a href="www.AndersonTownship.org">www.AndersonTownship.org</a> and a link available at <a href="www.facebook.com/AndersonTownshipOhio">www.facebook.com/AndersonTownshipOhio</a>, between November 20 and November 30, 2020



## Overview of CDBG Funding

- Hamilton County receives this funding every year from the US
   Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD)
- ☐ Funding is based on the budget passed by Congress every year
- ☐ The amount the County receives is based on the number of local governments that participate in the program and the following demographics for those communities: Population, Income Levels, Age of Population, Age of Housing Stock, Quality of Housing Stock, Economic Stability
- In recent years, funding has been stable at almost \$3 million per year
- ☐ The County budgets in three year cycles and splits the grant between community specific projects and county wide programs
- □ Each community requests funding that is about half of what they bring to the grant formula (in Anderson, about \$65,000/year)



## **CDBG Funding & Projects**

## CDBG funds are restricted to projects that:

- □ Benefit residents and businesses in a low to moderate income area (80% of less of area median income is considered low to moderate income see attached income limits document)
- Benefit low to moderate income households
- □ Remove slum and/or blight conditions this refers to acquisition and/or demolition of buildings that are no longer useful, or have code violations and are hazardous to the community


#### What can be funded?

- Improvements to public facilities such as parks and ballfields in low to moderate income areas
- ADA improvements to any publicly owned facilities such as parks, senior centers, government buildings, etc.

#### **Community Development Block Grant Program**

## Handicapped Ramp & Sidewalk Accessibility

- Anderson Township is seeking funding for one project, in 2022, which entails replacement of substandard handicapped ramps & deteriorated sidewalk segments at various locations in the community
- □ Total Project Cost: \$300,000
- ☐ Funding Request: \$210,000
  - Ensure ADA (Americans With Disability Act) compliance, and the directives of Anderson Township's ADA Transition Plan
  - □ Replacement of substandard handicapped ramps and adjoining curbs—Est. Cost \$1,000/ramp
  - □ Replacement of deteriorated sidewalk segments and lawn restoration Est. Cost \$500/block


