Comprehensive Plan Update

Anderson Tomorrow is a community-wide initiative to update the goals and policies of the Comprehensive Plan. Every five years the Township embarks on this process to reflect on what the community has accomplished in the previous five years and think about the next five years. Community members were invited to react to the comprehensive plan vision from 2016 and provide commentary on new topics or focus of interest this spring. Township planners have tapped into a myriad of methods of gathering information and opinions, including virtual meetings through Zoom, an online survey, and targeted outreach to students and seniors in the community. By updating the Comprehensive Plan every 5 years, Anderson Township seeks to ensure that key policy and planning decisions are consistent with the Township's long-range vision.

Community Art Plan

Anderson is embarking on a Community Art Plan which will define the community's values and special qualities and will translate those into public art. This plan will create a roadmap for how we begin to activate Anderson Township to implement and enjoy public art while also celebrating the Township's spirit and artistic expressions. We have held stakeholder meetings, two public engagement sessions, as well as an open house for the draft plan.

Clough Pike Study

Birthered out of a 2019 survey seeking residents' opinions about this stretch of roadway, the township has initiated changes that will improve traffic signals, sidewalk and pedestrian safety, turn lanes and more. We're thrilled that in a very short time frame, during the COVID pandemic, we were able to conduct an engineering study of this corridor, adopt a plan for improvements, and begin implementing some of these high-priority recommendations



Kellogg Gateway Study

Anderson Township is partnering with the City of Cincinnati and the California Neighborhood Business District to expand on the recommendations from the Ohio Riverfront Plan (adopted 2013) which "outlines a vision for strengthening the function, appearance, and economic potential of the Riverfront Area." After several events and meetings Anderson is getting ready to initiate the plan adoption process in September 2021.
