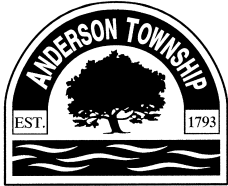

### Anderson Township Adopt-A-Roadway

Litter on roadways in Anderson Township is a continuing issue. This program is modeled after the “Adopt a Highway” programs that have been successful in keeping some State maintained roadways and other areas litter-free by periodically pick up litter on the adopted road.

The Township will provide gloves and bags used for the pickups. The bags will be left at the side of the road and picked up by the Township’s Public Works Department. It is hoped that the clean ups will happen multiple times a year. It is up to the individual or group when they wish to participate. Anderson Township can provide instructions, clean up materials and ask that the liability forms are returned to the Township.

Organizations and the roads they have adopted will be listed on the Township website and periodically in Township publications. In addition, Anderson Township provides designated signage on adopted roads, identifying the individual or group that is maintaining each road. ### Paint a Fire Hydrant

Looking for a unique service project, or a neighborhood beautification effort? Help maintain the township’s 2,700 + fire hydrants by providing them with a fresh coat of paint. Your efforts help firefighters do their job. Painting the hydrants helps increase visibility for firefighters who may need to access the hydrants during an emergency.

Anderson Township Fire and Rescue will provide volunteers with paint, a brush and instructions. Volunteers can request to paint hydrants in their own neighborhood or in other parts of the community.
