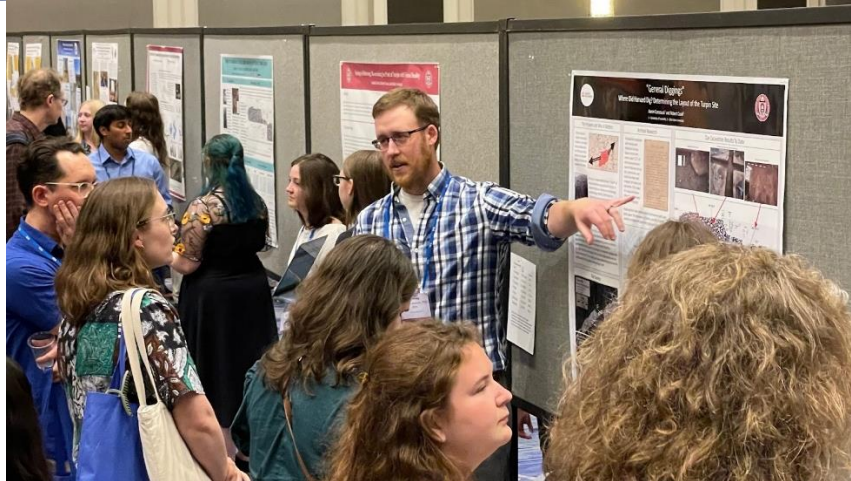
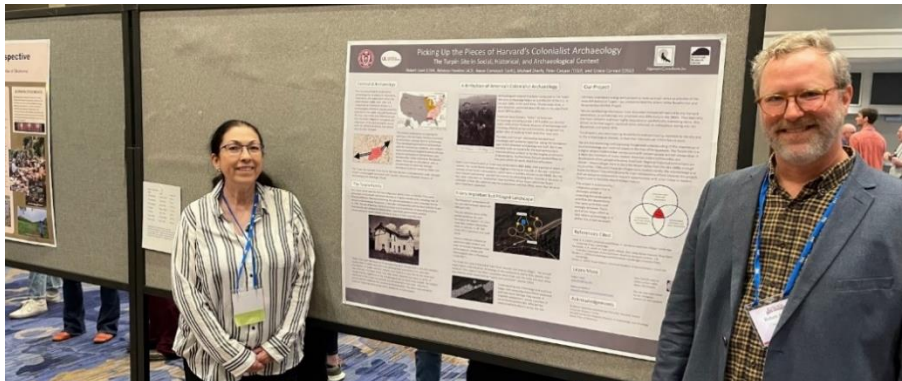

ATHS welcomes Dr. Robert Cook, Professor of Anthropology at OSU, and several of his colleagues and students to Anderson Township to continue their “recollect and reconnect” project. They are digging in areas that were previously excavated by Harvard University in the late 1800s **to more thoroughly document what they discovered and to facilitate reconnections by descendant groups to the site.** Archaeology has improved a hundredfold since the original excavations as has social interest in remedying some of the egregious wrongs concerning indigenous inhabitants of the region.

Dr. Rob Cook, OSU Professor, will give a brief overview of the project followed by poster presentations by many colleagues and students on excavation, pottery, arrowheads, virtual reality, and more. **Come hear all the details about this exciting local archaeology project!**
